1. Data controller

Eurotextilati Spa, with registered office in Dro (TN), loc. Pietramurata, Via Collungo 14, e-mail contact: info@eurotextilati.com, the data controller, guarantees compliance with legislation on the protection of personal data by providing the following information concerning the processing of data communicated or otherwise collected while browsing this website.

2. Data processed, purposes and legal basis of processing

Data generated by accessing the website

The IT systems and the software procedures for the functioning of this website acquire, during normal operations, certain personal data, the transmission of which is implicit in using Internet communication protocols. This data (such as, for example, domain names, IP addresses, operating system used, type of browser device used for the connection) is not accompanied by any additional personal information and is used to obtain anonymous statistical information on the use of the website, manage control requirements concerning how it is used and ascertain responsibility in the event of any cyber crimes. The legal basis legitimatising the processing of such data is the legitimate interest of the data controller. Such data is retained for a period of seven days.

Data provided voluntarily by the user

Personal data provided by the user through forms is collected and processed for the following purposes:

- a. to manage the relationship with the data subject (e.g. respond to requests for information, acquire preliminary information aimed at defining a contractual relationship, prepare commercial proposals, etc.);
- b. for administrative purposes and to carry out activities strictly related and instrumental to management of relations with data subjects and to fulfil legal obligations such as those of an accounting or tax nature, or to comply with requests from the judicial authorities;
- c. in the presence of specific consent, for the periodic sending, by e-mail, of newsletters and advertising material and updates on our activities;
- d. in the case of submission of a curriculum vitae, exclusively for selection purposes.

The legal basis legitimising processing for the purposes indicated above in points a. and b. is the need to implement a contract to which the data subject is a party or pre-contractual measures adopted at the request of the same (Art. 6(b) of the GDPR). For the purposes indicated in points c. and d., the legal basis is the consent freely provided by the data subject.

3. Nature of data provision

The provision of data with regard to the purposes referred to in points c. and d. is optional and its use is subject to the granting of explicit consent.

4. Processing methods and data retention periods

The data collected will be processed by electronic or in any case automated, computerised and telematic means, or by manual processing with rationale strictly related to the purposes for which the personal data was collected and, in any case, in such a way as to ensure its security.

5. Persons authorised for processing, processors and data communication

Processing of the data collected is carried out by personnel authorised for processing according to specific instructions provided in compliance with current legislation. The data collected, if necessary or instrumental to execution of the indicated purposes, may be processed by third parties appointed as data processors, or, where appropriate, communicated to the same as independent data controllers:

- parties that provide assistance and advice to our Company;

- parties entrusted with services connected with and instrumental to execution of the above mentioned purposes (e.g. IT system maintenance).

The complete and updated list of parties to which your personal data may be communicated can be requested at the registered office of the Controller. The data collected will not be transferred outside the EU and in any case, personal data will never be disseminated unless expressly authorised by the data subject.

6. Rights of the data subject

At any time data subjects can access their data, object to its processing or request erasure, modification or updating of all personal information collected by the controller, exercising the right to restriction of processing and the right to data portability, by sending an e-mail to info@eurotextilati.com.
